This is a comment on the proposed rulemaking " Date of Receipt of Electronic Submissions of Patent Correspondence," at 86 FR 69195 (12/7/2021).

In the proposed rule change to 37 CFR 1.6, which reads:

1.6 Receipt of Correspondence. (a) * * * (4)
Correspondence may be submitted using the Office electronic filing system only **in accordance with the Office electronic filing system requirements**. Correspondence officially submitted to the Office by way of the Office electronic filing system will be accorded a receipt date, which is the date in Eastern Time when the correspondence is received in the Office, regardless of whether that date is a Saturday, Sunday, or Federal holiday within the District of Columbia

What specifically does "**in accordance with the Office electronic filing system requirements**" mean?
