

FSA and FAFSA Step by Step – URLs and Graphic Example

To file a FAFSA, the student and parent both first need to get FSA IDs. Then they can fill out a FAFSA, or perform the annual renew/update of the student's FAFSA.

These slides show graphically the following actions

- FSA Get an FSA ID and account (Slides 3-8)
- FAFSA - Get a Copy of last year's SAR (Slides 9-12)
- FAFSA – Renew for coming year (Slides 13-33)
- Follow-up and Summary (Slide 34)

Important points

- Save FSA ID username and password *of student*, for future years.
- Save FSA ID username and password *of parent*, for future years.
- Remember that FSA ID login URL is not the same as the FAFSA application URL.

- Make sure to keep Federal tax filing records for student, and for parent, from 2 years in the past, for each year's new FAFSA.

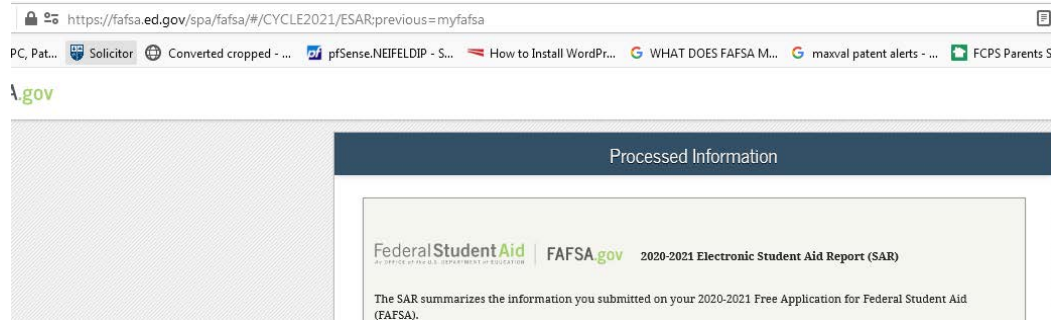

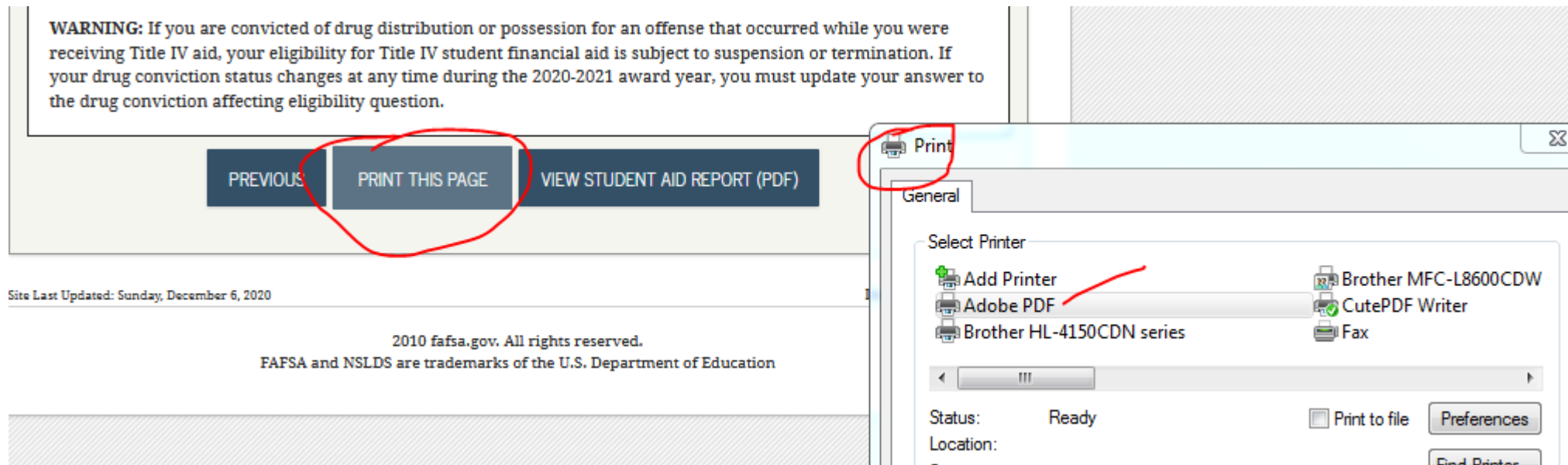
